

TAYLOR'S MUSIC STORE & STUDIOS COVID-19 POLICY (effective August 16th, 2021)

This policy may be amended as CDC guidelines are updated.

Due to the recent trend in positive cases and new information with regards to COVID, the infection rate in Chester County was reclassified as “**substantial**” by the Centers for Disease Control. This reclassification from “**moderate**” means it is recommended for everyone to wear masks indoors in public settings.

As of August 16th, 2021:

- All teachers and students are required to wear masks for in-person lessons at Taylor's.*
- It is encouraged that young students be dropped off for their in-person lesson to avoid overcrowding.
- While in studio waiting areas, masks are required for students and parents/guardians.
- Until further notice, only two people are permitted in each studio for in-person lessons.
- Students must wash/sanitize their hands prior to entering the studio for their in-person lesson.
- Remote lessons are still an option for those who prefer to continue online instruction.

*Woodwind and Brass students must wear an elongated mask and/or a mask with hole no larger than necessary to play the instrument. Bell covers are also strongly encouraged. Masks and bell covers are available for purchase at Taylor's in the Band & Orchestra department.

Regardless of vaccination, employees and visitors should not enter Taylor's if they are sick. Individuals who have a fever should stay at home until at least 24 hours after the fever has passed (which is a temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or 37.8 degrees Celsius or higher). Any person who has suffered from having flu-like symptoms, has been in close contact to someone who has COVID-19, or has been diagnosed with having COVID-19 may not enter Taylor's until the applicable quarantine period recommended by the CDC has elapsed. Recognizing that CDC guidelines are subject to change, all persons having any such symptoms, exposures, or diagnoses must review and follow the most current CDC recommendations before entering Taylor's.
