

## TAYLOR'S MUSIC STORE & STUDIOS COVID-19 POLICY

*This policy may be amended as CDC guidelines are updated.*

In conjunction with the change of masking policies in surrounding school districts, **as of February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022 masks are optional for all Taylor's customers, students, teachers, and employees.** Students/parents and their instructors may choose whether to wear a mask during lessons.

We kindly ask that you continue to follow these best practices:

- Wash or sanitize your hands before entering the studio. Hand sanitizer stations are in each waiting area and public restrooms are available on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors.
- Be respectful of the wishes of your peers and/or instructors. Have a mask with you in the event your teacher requests that masks be worn.
- If you are ill or feeling sick, please do not attend your in-person lesson. Contact your instructor ahead of time to request a remote lesson or schedule a make-up.
- When possible, maintain physical distance between you and your instructor inside the studio.

Recognizing that CDC guidelines are subject to change, all persons having any COVID-19 symptoms, exposures, or diagnoses must review and follow the most current CDC recommendations before entering Taylor's.
